How to make them

Cut out the six eggs on the opposite page. Fold the eggs in half lengthways and stack them on top of each other along the fold line.



Use small dots of glue to stick part of each egg to the next. Alternate between sticking a little less than half at the top and a little less than half at the bottom of the eggs together. This will create the effect you can see in the photo.

At the same time, glue a piece of string lengthways in the centre and leave some sticking out at the top, so you can hang the eggs up.

Finally, tie the ribbon to the top and your eggs are ready to hang up on your Easter tree or branch.
